Between 1800 and 1950, more than a million wolves were killed. During those time periods, one would earn money for bringing in a dead wolf. Even today, "wolf hunts"

are done for sport. Humans also harm the wolves' natural habitats. We have taken over their environments, and captured their food. We have also contaminated their water sources. Some forests inhabited by these animals have been cut down for our use, giving the wolves minimal places to live. Wolves are generally shy creatures. 
