Listen to Music - Music can do amazing things. It can calm our bodies and mentally heal us. It gives a chance to drift off a little bit, falling into another world...


Sleep - Lack of sleep can really build up stress. Try going to bed early one night. Maybe try again a couple nights later. See what I mean?

Financial systems that leverage Bitcoin. The **blockchain system** removes dependence on a centralized entity/Bank and instead distributes that authority across all the participants in the system.



So...You Know Your Math

The case of the missing Dollar \$

Three friends go to a restaurant. The check comes to \$15; each pays \$5.

The owner tells the cashier to return \$5 to the friends as an incentive for them to come back.

The cashier loses \$2 on the way, but hands over \$3 to the friends who keep \$1 each.

So, each friend ends up paying (\$5 - \$1) = \$4

Therefore, together they paid (\$4 x 3) = **\$12**

Cashier lost \$2
